All artists are invited to enter up to 3 artworks to be eligible to win prizes across 4 categories & best in show.

The artworks need to demonstrate at least 70% line work and we ask you to consider the following definitions when planning your artwork.

If AGRA deems the artwork is not a drawing it will not be hung.

Categories

- 1) Pencil
- 2) Pen or Pen/wash
- 3) Scratchboard / Metal point
- 4) Charcoal / Conté

- * Fine art drawing may be defined as the linear realization of visual objects, concepts, emotions and imaginings.
- * It is a way in which a subject is characterized mainly by line, with tone emphasizing form and shape, and monochrome in appearance rather than a mass.
- * The drawing is made with a pointed medium, achieving a varying weight or thickness of line. Mediums used are usually graphite pencil, charcoal, coloured pencil, pen and ink or metal-point. The drawing strokes and weight of line are used to control the appearance and feel of the form.

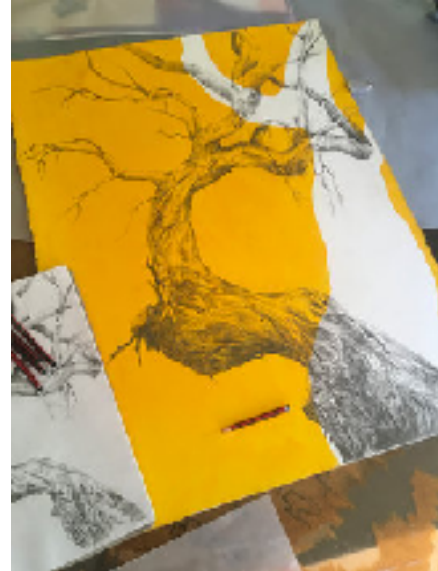
